~~~I have to submit a project frame for my board, but for now they are thinking it is good idea to test various collectors for oyster spat.

I was thinking that we could first apply for a Engage grant which allows 25K for 6 months from the CRSNG. It requires an industrial partner that will put some in kind (boat time, deployment of collectors, site or facilities access, etc). Engage grant partner needs to be an industry (municipalities are not considered but could be collaborators in my understanding) and requires an industry with a minimum of 2 full time employees. Is the company that you were referring to meet this criteria? Do you think we could go ahead with this approach?

For the project, it needs to be refined, but I could propose to do 1) a review of the methods used and collector types, 2) collector deployments at some sites during the summer season along with doing a monitoring of oysters maturation and then 3) a review and technical perspective for spat collection from collectors. It will allows to identify the weakness of the process and we could thereafter work on refining the methods /timing of deployments/retrieval. ~~~

I have copied Alain and the warden to inform them that [REDACTED] (a marine science organization based in Quebec) is hoping to do a couple projects in our water.

Details of project #1 :

- 1) a review of the methods used and collector types,
- 2) collector deployments at some sites during the summer season along with doing a monitoring of oysters maturation and then
- 3) a review and technical perspective for spat collection from collectors.

It will allow to identify the weakness of the process and we could thereafter work on refining the methods /timing of deployments/retrieval.

After we meet, we will have more details.

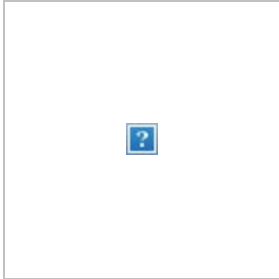

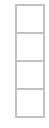
