Background:

The Wedgeport Waste Water Project Phase 2 was successfully completed by end of February 2019 with 42 out of 44 budgeted installed on-site sewers. The upcoming fiscal year would be considered as our first operating year for the Wedgeport Waste Water Management District. As stipulated in our By-Law #37 – Wedgeport Wastewater District under Sentence 7 Council shall appoint a Wastewater Management Committee to review and report on the management and operation of the WWMD it is required to form a committee for this matter.

Staff had posted a request for volunteers to all residents that were involved in the project and received three responses from interested residents. To form the committee it would be recommended to have council chair the committee and have at least 2 staff members as voting members present. Overall the committee would consist of 7 voting members (2 council, 2 staff and 3 public).

Staff is requesting respectfully to approve the motion to have councils support for the set up of the Wedgeport Wastewater Management Committee as outlined below.
