**Re:** Post-disaster building exemption status for New Municipal Administration Building

As per the National building Code of Canada 2015 Volume 1 (section 1-10, Division A), Post-disaster building means a building that is essential to the provision of services in the event of a disaster, and includes:

- buildings of the following types, unless exempted from this designation by the authority having jurisdiction:
  - emergency response facilities,
  - fire, rescue and police stations and housing for vehicles, aircraft or boats used for such purposes, and
  - communications facilities, including radio and television stations

Require post-disaster exemption status from council for the New Municipal Administration Building, based upon the above building code.
