Re: Renaming of Bernard A Pothiers Lane, Upper Wedgeport

This memo relates to a road name change petition for “Bernard A Pothiers Lane” in Upper Wedgeport. It is to be presented to Council at the next meeting on September 8, 2020. Approval of a private road name change is done by the Civic Addressing Coordinator as per Article C25, Naming of Municipal Streets and Private Roads. This letter requires no action by Council and is simply for their information.

On February 1, 2019 I responded to a request for information by Councilor LeBlanc via email and provided details on changing a private road name. This was forwarded to the interested party. On August 2, 2020 I received an email from Councilor LeBlanc informing me that a road name change petition had been completed, and I replied with further instructions on August 5, 2020. Also on August 5, 2020, I received an email with a scanned version of the petition and I received the hardcopy version by mail on August 12, 2020.

The road name change petition package is complete and contains the signature of 3 of 4, or 75% of the residents on “Bernard A Pothiers Lane”. The petition requests that the road name be changed to “Jane’s Lane”. The original homestead on the private road belonged to Narcisse and Jane Boudreau. The petition was filled in good order with no issues.

I approve the road name change. There are no other roads named “Jane’s Lane” in the province and there are no road names containing “Jane” in the Tri-Counties.
