Re: Mariners Centre Management Board Nominations

This year, two spots opened up for the Mariners Centre Management Board, one from Municipality of Yarmouth and one from Municipality of Argyle. The Mariners Centre Nomination Committee advertised for these positions and received two resumes for the Argyle Region.

The committee met and reviewed applications received and came to a decision. The decision was already approved by the Board itself in a vote in August. The board has come forward with a recommendation to council for approval of their new board member for the Municipality of Argyle:

Wendy Dupley, who has served as both Executive Director of Economic Development for the City of Abbotsford BC and Director of Economic Development for the City of Maple Ridge. She is also President of the Economic Developers Association of Canada. Now living on Robert's Island, she runs her own independent consulting firm, WeDu Consulting.

A motion is required to approve this recommendation to have Wendy Dupley sit on the Mariners Centre Management Board.
