Jan 11 - Tri county Housing. A presentation by Karen Brodeur from Compass Co-op giving us an update on their progress on some of their projects, specifically the Barton school. They are finally nearing the point where they will be able to start the actual work as there have been a number of issues, mostly from government funding.
