#### Palliative Care vs Hospice care

Palliative Care starts when a patient is diagnosed with a terminal illness.

aims to improve patient quality of life during treatment for the underlying condition by addressing issues such as fatigue, weakness, anxiety or depression.

Hospice Care refers to end-of-life care.

 commences in-hospital or at-home when there is no hope of patient recovery, and end of life is imminent.

#### What does the Society do?

Support organizations that provide palliative, and dignified end-of-life care services:

- Nova Scotia Health,
- Yarmouth Hospital Foundation,
- Victoria Order of Nurses.
- Hospice rooms supplement the NSH mandate
  - -unique space environment where people can end life with dignity and comfort
  - -provides families with a more peaceful and less stressful experience.

## Society History

- Established as a Charitable Society in 2004
- Evaluated Hospice Options
  - Free standing building
  - Located within Existing Nursing Home
  - Located within the Yarmouth Regional Hospital
- July 2019
  - Approval granted by HSH to locate 7 hospice rooms within 4N
- Jan 2021
  - Hospice rooms placed in service
- Society has funded ~ \$145,000 in total

## In 4N - Palliative Care Unit at YRH

- Secured/furnished seven hospice rooms on 4N:
  - One Cuddle bed.
  - Folding beds for family support members.
  - SMART TVs.
  - Blinds.
  - Quilts.
  - Lamps.
- Secured/furnished family room on 4N.
  - ► Furniture.
  - Service Cart, coffee machine, kettle, water pitchers, coffee
  - mugs.
  - Mini Fridge.

# **VON Support**

- Purchased 42 Oximeters.
- Purchased 10 pain pump pouches
- Purchased a mattress for a stretcher for the Yarmouth Office.

### **Current Municipal Requests**

- Mun of Clare \$1,530 to fund 5 pain pump pouches
- Mun of Barrington \$ 1,530 to fund 5 pain pump pouches
- Fund a \$21,000 cuddle bed
  - Mun of Argyle \$5,000
  - Mun of Yarmouth \$5,000
  - ► Town of Yarmouth \$5,000
  - ► Society \$6,000
