EXECUTIVE COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
THURSDAY, APRIL 27, 2023

1. **Call Meeting to Order**

Warden Danny Muise called the meeting to order at 6:32 p.m.

2. **Invitation to Stand and Move**

Warden Danny Muise reminded Council that they are permitted to stand and move as they need to during the meeting. This is a new initiative introduced by Argyle Recreation which normalizes movement in meetings.

- Authorize Staff to schedule a public hearing held concurrently for the proposed Land Use By-Law amendment and development agreement.
