**Re:** YASTA By-Laws

- 1. The addition of a representative from Wasoqopa'q First Nation
- 2. Updates to definitions, precisely defining tourism experience and the skills the board would be looking for board members.
- 3. MPLAC is no longer referenced as a partner explicitly in the bylaws. However, the bylaws added a section that states there would be three seats from accommodations with 20+ rooms.
- 4. Other accommodation types can now be represented on the board, too, through the appointment of two non-elected members from each municipal council.
- 5. Roles and Elections, to read that "the chair will be appointed on a rotational basis every four years (after each municipal election) and will be the elected official appointed by a municipal partner to the board of YASTA.
