Vision statement

CAO's Recommendation:

That the staff report as presented by our Executive Assistant be approved by Council. Under the current offer, E-Scribe may be secured for a one time fee of \$1,175 and an annual software fee of \$7,800. As indicated in the request from staff, the software fee will offset the costs of preparing for council and executive committee meetings, not including the savings of time from other staff members. Furthermore, the software shall improve our execution of meeting agenda, preparation and minutes of subcommittee meetings which would benefit from more organization and public information.

It should be noted that the initial fee is within our software capital budget at this time.

Suggested motion:

That the CAO be tasked with securing E-Scribe meeting management services, at an initial cost of \$1,175, along with current software fees.

Please note, future software fees shall be included for consideration as part of the future operational budget process.
