Subject: Request for Wharf Usage – Comeau's Hill Wharf

Dear Members of the Council,

I am writing on behalf of Acadian Seaplants to formally request authorization to access and operate on Comeau's Hill wharf, at 2523 Comeau's Hill Road, within your municipality. Our company sustainably harvests and processes seaweed in Yarmouth County, and access to this wharf would be essential to support the harvesting activities in the Municipality of Argyle.

We respectfully request permission to:


- Access the wharf between October 1st and May 15th of each year
- Berth of up to two rockweed (up to 21 feet LOA) boats
- Park unloading equipment, consisting of one log loader and one truck box, on the wharf during the permitting timeframe

As part of our operation on Comeau's Hill wharf, we will ensure the wharf and used areas are kept clean, install protective boards on the wooden surface of the wharf to avoid chafing, and ensure boats are properly tied. No long-term parking of vehicles on the wharf or the surrounding parking will be required, as well as no activities will take place within the adjacent picnic area. Acadian Seaplants is covered by a \$2,000,000.00 liability insurance for all wharf operations, which will cover Comeau's Hill wharf.

I am happy to provide any documentation you feel necessary. Please let me know if there are forms, permits, or additional requirements I should complete as part of this process.
